
## Will's Weekly Meta: Lines of Reasoning

Solution: If you read the instructions I provided in last week's email, hopefully you noticed a couple of things pretty quickly. First, the word "long" was used 4 times, and it didn't exactly blend in well. So, there's a break in standard crossword conventions. Next, all of these answers with "long" were vertical. Vertical themed answers are rare, so that's another clue. The title was "Lines of Reasoning" and the answer was a place on Earth, so hopefully you realized that "long" in this case represented lines of Longitude, which explains why those answers were vertical. And, once you established that, hopefully it was a quick realization that there must also be lines of Latitude, and to match the "long" answers, you were simply looking for "lat" hidden in across answers. After that, you're looking for the intersection of the Lat and Long words, because the intersection of Latitude and Longitude is a common way to define or identify a place on Earth. Those four letters at the intersections were IIJF, and when unscrambled, spell **FIJI**, the solution to the meta.
